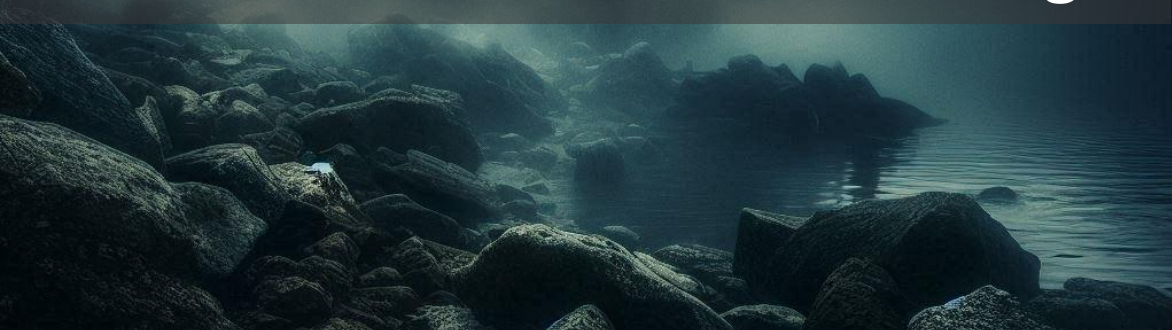




The Castle of Whispers

The Castle of Saint Torment
